Biographical and historical information: Mary Hinckley Hutchings Crane (1914-2007) was a part-time Barnstable resident, teacher, docent, volunteer, and voracious reader. She wrote this "theme" at the age of 17 on the cranberry culture of Cape Cod, and consulted many local cranberry growers during the writing of the 30-page paper. The Crane family still summers in Barnstable Village as of this writing.
