**Scope and Content Note:** A collection of bylaws, annual reports, program fliers, newspaper articles, and other documents relating to the history of the Barnstable Woman's Club and the Village Hall of Barnstable.

**Historical and Biographical Information:** The Barnstable Woman's Club was established in 1922 to "bring together all women interested in the Village of Barnstable and to further the intellectual and social life of its members, and through them become a power for good in the community." Committees included Art & Travel, Community Service, Home Economics, Literature, Music, Press, Hospitality, Program, and Custodian.
