Scope and Content Note: The collection consists primarily of papers, correspondence, articles, photographs, and artifacts related to Bruce K. Jerauld, his son Gordon O. Jerauld, and Bruce's sister Annabelle Jerauld Trayser.

Biographical Information: The Jerauld Family has deep roots on Cape Cod, dating back to the 18th century. Bruce K. Jerauld of Barnstable served as Barnstable County Treasurer for 42 years from 1930 to 1972. He was married to J. Lucile Thayer. His son Gordon was born and raised in Barnstable and served in the military during World War II, and went on to live all over the world, settling in Florida where he served as a Senior Vice President for Florida Public Utilities. Gordon was married to Ruth Annie Johnson for 63 years.

Jerauld’s wife’s family). Teacup dated August 31, 1852 and saucer dated 1902 and marked “Lucile”. It possibly commemorated the 50th wedding anniversary of John Otis Thayer and Sarah Elizabeth Peirce, and may have been handpainted by their daughter Lucile (Thayer) Jerauld.
